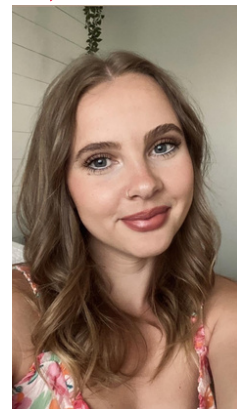
Staff Shout-Outs!

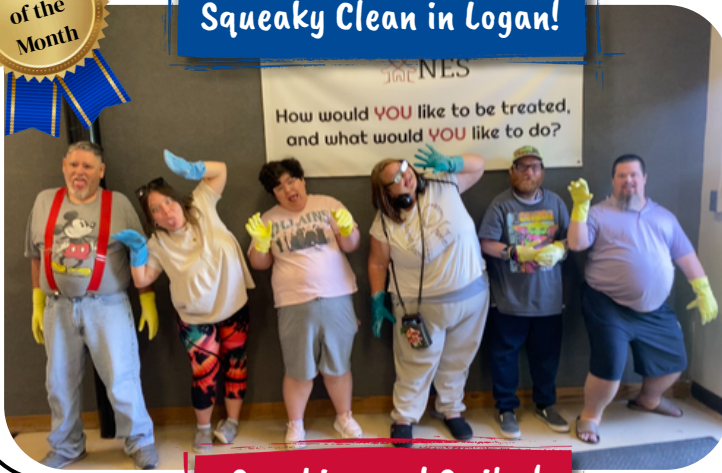

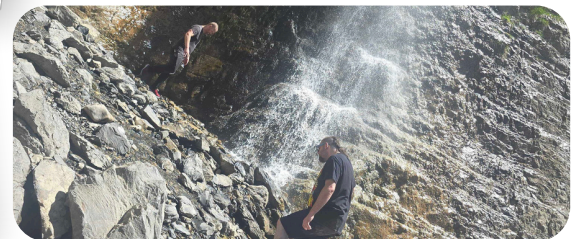
